#### **Outcomes**

#### Task description

**Artmaking**: You are to complete a mini-Body of Work (BOW). Your Body of Work should demonstrate conceptual meaning and the development of technical skills. You may work with any materials and explore any concept you like. Your BOW must reflect 10 weeks of work.

Proposal: Must complete an artist proposal worksheet and submit it in your Visual Arts diary.

Visual Arts Diary: development of ideas through (written and or material practice). This can look like:

- Sketches and planning
- written notes about your concept and materials
- experimenting with materials and techniques

#### Artist's Practice-Research Task

- You will select a contemporary practicing artist of your choice and complete an ARTISTS PRACTICE
  handout (attached)
- You will research and include a brief biography, a detailed description of one of their works and outline their Artmaking Practice- CONCEPTS & MATERIALS- IDEAS & ACTIONS. Create a short podcast or brochure to present your artist research. Include the artist's biography, a description of at least one artwork, and details about their practice—concepts, materials, ideas, and actions. This task helps you communicate how the artist connects with the artwork, world, and audience.
