TASK DESCRIPTION

COMPOSITION + PORTFOLIO (25%)

You will need to complete a composition task for your Preliminary assessment mark. Your composition must be a minimum of 2 minutes in duration and include a portfolio/composition diary.

At least one layer in your composition MUST be notated with traditional notation.

VIVA VOCE (15%)

Viva-Voces must not exceed ten-minutes in length and must feature an instrument and its repertoire, with a focus on the Concepts of Music. To support your discussion, the presentation must include examples as; audio clips, diagrams, scores, or live demonstrations.
