Task description

You are to conduct an historical investigation based on an area of your personal interest in modern history. For this task the period of modern history is from 1750 – 2011.

The completion of this task will require you to:

- Pick an area of personal interest
- Come up with a guestion or hypothesis based on your topic of personal interest
- Locate, select and analyse information/evidence from a wide range of sources
- Present the findings of your investigation
- Include a bibliography of correctly referenced sources
- Maintain a process log for the duration of your investigation

Your investigation can be presented in any appropriate manner, including:

- Essay format (1000 1200 words)
- 'Ted Talk'
- Website or multimedia presentation (1000 -1200 word equivalent)
- Multi-model presentation
- Speech
