Task description

Part 1 (10 marks): You will create extended response plans for BOTH of the following questions:

Question 1

"To what extent was Greek victory due to Sparta in the Persian Wars?"

Question 2

"Assess the impact of the transformation of the Delian League on the changing nature of Athenian imperialism in this period."

The plans MUST NOT be in the form of a pre-written response. You should use your plan to practice writing essays in your own time in preparation for the timed in-class response.

Part 2 (20 marks): In class, you will be given the option of ONE of the above questions to answer as an extended response. You will not be told which question you will be required to answer until the day of the task. You will:

- be given 45 minutes to write your response
- be allowed to use your plan to help you write your response.
- You must submit BOTH extended response plans on the day the response is completed in class.
- Both extended response plans and your written response will be marked for this assessment task.
- You are allowed to submit draft plans only for feedback.
