Outcomes

- 2.4 analyses the role of a range of environmental factors that have an impact on the lives of young children
- 2.5 examines strategies that promote safe environments

Task description

The National Action Plan for the Health of Children and Young People: 2020-2030 (COAG, 2019) recognises empowering parents and caregivers to maximise healthy development of children as one of its priority areas.

It found "the healthy development of children and young people is directly related to the nature and quality of parenting."

Promoting parenting education and information through parenting apps or hardcopy resources were identified as strategies to improve children's health.

Your task is to research one of the following child health issues and create an information resource for parents.

- 1. Immunisation
- 2. Infant Mortality
- 3. Childhood Injuries
- 4. Juvenile Diabetes
- 5. Childhood Obesity
- 6. Mental Health
- 7. Chronic Respiratory Illnesses

Your child health resource must provide information, examples and diagrams to educate parents about the issue and how to seek support. You should:

- 1. **Describe** [provide characteristics/features] of the child health issue you are researching.
- 2. **Account** [state reasons] for how prevalent or common it is in the community.
- 3. **Explain** [provide reasons how/why] the issue's effect on young children and families.
- 4. **Examine** [inquire into] methods to reduce the negative impacts of this issue.
- 5. **Identify** [recognize and name] health or support services where further information may be accessed, including contact details.
- 6. Reference all sources consulted in a bibliography. NB. If Al is used as a tool for research, prompts used to refine your search must be recorded as part of your bibliography and original references credited as sources.

Al prompt examples:

- A) "What are the most common health conditions that affect infants and their symptoms?"
- B) "Refine for results in Australia"
- C) "Provide sources of information from the last 5 years"

Remember to **avoid plagiarism**, including "...submitting a written or practical task that's been completed for you in whole or in part by someone else – this includes generative AI". All work must be your own!


