## THE BIG SCREEN- English in Film Making ANALYSIS OF FILM

Part A - Create a film review on the text 'Eddie the Eagle' studied in this module.

The review must be at least 600 words.

Use the scaffold for writing a review which has been used in your class study.

The task will be written in class over three lessons, edited and published in class time from prepared study notes.

**Part B** — Convert a scene from the film 'Eddie the Eagle' that includes the protagonist into a short narrative of approximately 400 words written in 1<sup>st</sup> person narration. Structure your story with an orientation, problem, rising action, resolution and conclusion.

You will be assessed on your ability to:

- Compose a written film review using personal voice and the language of film
- Show evidence of understanding ideas and techniques used in film
- Recognise intended audience
- Include personal response and reflection on aspects of film
- Compose a short 1<sup>st</sup> person narration by converting a scene from the film using correct narrative structure.
