<b>Detail</b>	<b>0</b> Includes no activities in the schedule. Not colour coded.	<b>1</b> Includes few activities in the schedule. Most activities missing from the schedule. Inaccurately or incompletely colour coded.	<b>2</b> Includes a moderate number of activities. Moderate amount of activities missing. Colour coded but not to a satisfactory level.	<b>3</b> Includes most activities in the schedule. Minimal amount of missing activities. Colour coded to a satisfactory level.	<b>4</b> Includes all activities in the schedule. No activities missing. Colour coded to a high level and key included.	<b>5</b> Includes all activities in the schedule with high level of detail. Colour coding is highly accurate and accurate key included.
<b>Accuracy</b>	<b>0</b> Schedule is highly inaccurate or unrealistic.	<b>1</b> Schedule is minimally accurate and realistic.	<b>2</b> Schedule is moderately accurate and realistic.	<b>3</b> Schedule is mostly accurate and realistic.	<b>4</b> Schedule is accurate and realistic.	<b>5</b> Schedule accurately represents three days and is highly realistic.

Includes sound justification of choices.	<b>8</b> Describes all components of the schedule. Includes satisfactory and multiple calculations. Includes sound justifications.	<b>9</b> Explains all components of the schedule. Includes complex and multiple calculations. Includes sophisticated justifications.	<b>10</b> Analyses all components of the schedule. Includes complex and multiple calculations. Includes sophisticated justifications.
