Outcomes:

Task Description:

Portfolio of Writing Activities:

Students have undertaken a range of writing activities in a variety of forms, styles and purposes during Semester 1. This digital or physical portfolio will be a review and collection of their work revised and reflected upon in order to demonstrate their diligence.

The portfolio must include:

- 1. A narrative piece
- 2. A persuasive piece
- 3. At least 3 other pieces of work undertaken during the semester
- 4. A 200 word reflection statement that describes the process of your review, revision and final portfolio production.

You will be assessed on:

- 1. The engaging quality of your responses
- 2. The technical accuracy of your work, according to the criteria that you have been self assessing and peer assessing to during the unit
- 3. Your ability to reflect on feedback, revise work according to that feedback and produce an improved end product
- 4. How well presented and organised your portfolio is.

You will be given a two week assessment period in order to complete your portfolio of work. This work is 100% in class assessment.
