Outcomes

Task description

You will be required to complete a source analysis for each of the following topics:

- The Kokoda Campaign
- Prisoners of War (World War II)
- Aboriginal Service (World War II)
- The experience of Women (World War II)

Part One:

You will be required to select **ONE** source **per topic** to analyse, meaning that you will complete a total of **FOUR** source analyses. You will have a choice of three sources per topic to choose from. You do not need to complete analysis for all 12 of the source options; however, you may wish to do so to help you complete the second part of the task.

Part Two:

Once you have completed your source analysis, using your own knowledge and with reference to at least ONE source you will need to construct a paragraph to answer each of the following questions.

- 1. Using your own knowledge and with reference to at least one source, explain the experience of soldiers during the Kokoda campaign.
- 2. Using your own knowledge and with reference to at least one source, explain the experience of prisoners of war.
- 3. Using your own knowledge and with reference to at least one source, explain the experience of Aboriginal service men and women.
- 4. Using your own knowledge and with reference to at least one source, explain the experience of Women on the Australian home front.

Once you have used the provided scaffold, you should type your final paragraph in a word processing document with correct formatting. You should include a bibliography if you use other sources to research and support your answer.
