**Outcomes**

**Task description**

**Context for the Task**

Students are asked to experience and examine the complexities of becoming a parent. Students are required to create a nursery. When caring for an infant, it is important that students understand and appreciate the financial cost and basic needs of a young child's life.

**Outline of the task:**

**In this task, you are required to care for an Egg Baby and design a nursery.** You will be required to use an egg from home and to care for your egg for three days. You need to give your egg a name and keep it by your side at all times over the three-day period. If you are required to go out without your egg, you must organise a babysitter.

**Part 1 - Design a Nursery**

Design a nursery using a shoebox for your newborn. In your nursery you must:

- Colour the walls using paint, wallpaper, wrapping paper, etc.
- Include a door and a window.
- Use at least two materials as furnishing e.g. blinds on the window, floor rug, carpet etc
- Include at least seven items in your nursery such as a cot, change table, wall art, chair, cupboard/wardrobe, bookshelf, toys or crafted items depicting what you would expect to have inside the nursery. The items you include need to be relatively proportionate to your nursery. Note: You can either make the furniture or use dolls furniture.

**Part 2 - Google Slideshow**

- **Egg Birth Certificate:** You are to create a birth certificate for your egg which includes your eggs name, gender, DOB, place of birth, mother's name and a picture of you and your egg.
- **Video of Nursery:** You are to create a video giving a tour of your nursery **explaining** five safety considerations you have implemented in your nursery. Your video needs to be uploaded to your Google Slideshow.
- **Diary:** Each day, for 3 days, you must complete at least ONE diary entry which **recalls** what you and your egg did during the day (include at least one picture each day) and **discuss** your experience of being a parent and caring for your egg (positive and negative experiences during the day, how you feel about caring for your egg etc).

Time will be allocated in class for discussion, clarification and completion of this task. However, it will require some work to be completed at home.

**Explain** - Relate cause and effect; make the relationships between things evident; provide why and/or how

**Recall** - present remembered ideas, facts or experiences

**Discuss** - Identify issues and provide points for and/or against.
