Dear Parents, Caregivers and School Community

The current events find us in unchartered territory. Please know all of the RRHC staff are supporting the development of the best way forward for our young people.

The Premier of NSW has strongly encouraged families to keep children at home. If this is not possible for our parents who are engaged in essential services, our site will be open with staff present to supervise students' flexible learning. Social distancing guidelines will be strictly applied. Students must bring their own food as the canteen is closed. Extra-curricular activities will not take place, and supervision will be provided on site between 8.30 am - 3.30 pm.

Richmond River High Campus will be moving to flexible distance learning this week. Teachers will continue to prepare units of work that can be completed by students if they are at home or at school. Flexible distance learning includes online learning platforms and off-line or non-digital content such as worksheets, workbooks or text books. Please be patient with our dedicated teaching and learning staff as they work to support your child. Richmond River High Campus approach is to use Google Classroom as the online learning platform and printed material will be available to be collected from the school office as requested by parents from Friday afternoon, whilst the school remains open. Where Internet and computer access is available parents and carers are asked to ensure that your child checks their emails and Google Classroom daily.

Some classes may also use additional platforms and resources. Video conferencing tools are being explored but may not be used straight away. Communication regarding these technologies will occur after processes have been put in place for their use. A summary outlining flexible distance learning in each subject or course is provided on the attached pages at the end of this letter.

In the short term for the next 1-2 weeks Year 11 and Year 12 students will follow their usual timetable as a guide for when they should be accessing and completing flexible learning. Students in Years 7-10 will follow a modified timetable. This modified timetable will be emailed to all parents, will be available on the Sentral Dashboard daily notices and printed copies will be available to be collected from the school office. We will provide further advice regarding timetables and any changes.

Any in class assessment tasks will now be postponed to a date to be republished to students. We wait for further advice form NESA with regards how to support our HSC students in this respect. NESA is meeting Tuesday 24th March to discuss the ongoing learning of senior students, particularly in the context of the HSC. Be sure to look after yourselves, your families and friends in these uncertain times.


